

## MFL Mar Mac Booster Club Notes

April 6, 2014 Meeting

**Call meeting to order:** By President Chad Keehner @ 6:00 pm at MFL MarMac High School library in Monona.

**Secretary's Report:** No notes to report as Jo was unable to open the attachment of notes from Stacie. Jason is going to work on converting this for us.

**Treasurer's Report:** Discussed moving \$5000 from savings to checking to cover upcoming invoices. Darren mentioned the early discount for the HUDL program if ordered by April/May, Jason will look into this. Reviewed

**Bills to be Paid:** Up to date; Darren reported no outstanding invoices in his possession. Jo mentioned not seeing the track uniform invoice yet from Coach Becky Holt.

**Special Guests and Requests:** Request by Dawn Colsch for 15 new Varsity cheerleading uniforms. She noted she can order the same style uniforms that were ordered 5 years ago. Cost would be \$220/uniform for the unifit shell and skirt. Uniforms are used for football, basketball and wrestling for both Varsity and JV. Heidi motioned to approve up to \$3500 and Jo 2<sup>nd</sup>.

Jason Halvorson requested that one set of basketball uniforms (either home or away) for each the boys and girls teams are needed. Usually they get an Under Armor uniform. 1 set is \$115 with 15 members on each the boys and girls teams. Total of 30 uniforms will be needed. Heidi approved up to \$4000 and was seconded by Collin.

### **Athletic Directors:**

**Jason Halvorson** – Was going to check with the school about the bronze bulldog statue in front of the school. No word on that from last fall. Cost was going to be around \$9300 total and funds raised for this so far were around \$4000-\$4500. Jason will bring us up to date on the totals raised at the next meeting and see what the Booster Club could donate at that time. Nothing further.

**Old Business: Concessions ideas:** adding cotton candy and no tacos will eliminate our having to monitor the temperature of the meat to meet the food inspectors' criteria. We will offer chicken sandwiches, 1/2lb hotdogs, pizzas and candy. This will also make it much easier for baseball and softball concessions.

**Tae Kwon Do Tournament:** Saturday, May 3<sup>rd</sup>- Jo will add this to the concession schedule for workers

**Spring Apparel Order:** Order forms are out and due back in on Monday, April 7<sup>th</sup>. We will extend towards the end of the week due to a delay in the order forms getting to McGregor center. Erin will take care of submitting to Sports World.

**Golf Tourney:** Jo explained the Golf fundraiser is being worked on for June 14<sup>th</sup> @ Tri City Golf Course starting at 8 am. Will need help from Booster club members for this. The cost last year was \$140 entry fee for each team of four which includes lunch and bottle of water for each team member. Hoping to have 18 teams this year, please pass the word as this is a really fun tournament and a good way to raise money for the Booster Club. Was decided to keep the price the same and mailings for this would go out soon. Would keep the hole sponsorship the same as last year also at \$75.

Jo discussed the different twists for holes and payouts. Details on food menu is still being worked on and we have not received a menu from Tri City yet. Jo presented what was mailed out last year to the coaches, staff and businesses. Asked for any suggestions of change? Will keep the challenges we have in place the same and maybe add a few new ones.
